Perched high in the Belvédère area, at the foot of the Rond-Point des Pistes, Le Coucou is nestled in one of the most scenic spots in Méribel, right by the slopes. Since December 2019, the hotel has stood in harmony with the snowy peaks, overlooking the entire valley. Part of the Maisons Pariente collection of hotels, Le Coucou opens each year from early December to the end of March.

With 55 rooms, including 39 suites, 2 private chalets, ski-in/ski-out access, 3 restaurants, a spa, a Kids Club and Teens Lab, and both indoor and outdoor pools, Le Coucou is tucked away within a charming wooden chalet, reminiscent of the playful bird from which it takes its name. Here, Le Coucou offers a chic and relaxed mountain lifestyle, where five-star luxury elevates every experience thanks to the attentive service of its team. Unconventional, surprising, never expected, and never seen before, Le Coucou sings a tune that everyone loves—the exhilarating joy of a holiday and the thrill of living each moment to the fullest.

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A Reimagined Chalet Full of Hidden Charms

It's a game of hide and seek, where guests think they're entering a cosy chalet only to find themselves in a grand, cathedral-like reception hall. Le Coucou masterfully balances contrasts—monumental yet intimate, rigid geometric lines against soft, flowing forms, vintage blended with contemporary creations, pristine regularity juxtaposed with artisanal imperfections, wood paired with stone, fabrics with metal, glass with leather.

Through a holistic architectural approach that integrates layout and decor, Pierre Yovanovitch brings a fresh, contemporary perspective to classic Alpine style, maintaining a refined warmth with playful twists. Antique furnishings sit alongside pieces designed by the architect, who has woven in delightful details: bird-claw feet (naturally), old-style ski poles, owl-shaped hooks, and frosted glass light fixtures that resemble melting icicles—small nods to the playful cuckoo that emerges from its chalet to chime each hour.

Among Le Coucou's rooms and suites, the Ernestine and Eloïse suites stand out for their family-friendly design. At around 100 and 120 square meters, respectively, these suites provide a haven for families to enjoy Méribel in cosy comfort. Each suite offers two separate bedrooms with private bathrooms, a living room, and a kitchenette, creating a true home in the mountains for families and groups of friends.

Le Coucou is complemented by two private chalets for rent—Églantine and Éléonore—luxurious, cosy spaces designed for ultimate relaxation. Independent yet connected to the hotel through an interior passage, these chalets offer full access to all of Le Coucou's five-star services.

Each chalet spans four floors and approximately 600 square meters, comfortably accommodating up to 12 guests, making them ideal for extraordinary family holidays. Fully outfitted with four bedrooms, four bathrooms, a kitchen, a living room with breathtaking views, a play area and TV lounge, private pool and spa, as well as a ski room with ski-in/ski-out access, each chalet provides an intimate and convivial mountain retreat. A Festive-Chic Bistronomic Restaurant


