To mark the fifth anniversary of Maisons Pariente, co-founders Kimberley Cohen and Leslie Kouhana are proud to unveil the Prix Maisons Pariente, an art competition created to spotlight the vibrant emerging art scene in France. This initiative reflects the group's deep commitment to artistic creation, offering a platform to uncover young talent and support them in their creative journeys.

The competition has now opened its call for entries, inviting applications from students and recent graduates of prominent French art institutions, including Ecole Camondo (the event's partner), Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts, Ecole Boulle, Ecole Estienne, Penninghen, Ecole Duperré, Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Arts Décoratifs, Ecole de Sèvres, and Ecole Nationale Supérieure de Création Industrielle.

Participants are tasked with creating an original artwork to "dress a wall," exploring any medium (photography, video, AI, painting, collage, plaster, engraving, sculpture, ceramics, etc.) and interpreting the theme "From real journeys to imaginary ones, how does reality shape our dreams?" The work should be transportable and, depending on the medium, approximately equivalent to an AI format.

The distinguished jury, composed of eight notable figures from the art and design world, includes **Charles Zana**, renowned architect; **Amélie du Chalard**, Founder of Amélie Maison d'Art gallery; **Michèle Dard**, Director of Ecole Camondo; **Julia Rouzaud**, Founder of Goodmoods; **Isabelle Dubern**, Co-founder of The Invisible Collection; **Isis Colombe-Combréas**, Co-founder of Milk Decoration; and Maisons Pariente's co-founders **Kimberley Cohen and Leslie Kouhana**.

Artists must submit their applications by midnight on January 31, 2025. From the submissions, ten finalists will be selected, with three winners receiving cash prizes of \in 5,000, \notin 3,000, and \notin 2,000 respectively.

The winners will be announced on March 21, 2025, during an exclusive cocktail event in partnership with Taittinger at the Amélie Maison d'Art gallery in Paris, where the finalists' works will be presented and celebrated. The first prize winner's artwork will also be exhibited in one of the group's properties, offering invaluable exposure to a discerning French and international audience. In addition, the winner's piece will be showcased on the Goodmoods platform, with a feature in MilK Magazine.

Art has always been an intrinsic passion for the Pariente family and is a defining element in each of the Maisons Pariente hotels, which are carefully curated with distinct identities and refined artistic narratives.
